CARING FOR

INDOOR FERNS

Sunlight (or lack thereof)

- Ferns are known for thriving in low to moderate light conditions. They are excellent choices for shaded areas or rooms with indirect light.
- Keep them away from direct sunlight, as this can scorch their delicate fronds.

Watering

- Maintain evenly moist soil. Water when the top inch of soil feels slightly dry to the touch.
- Use room temperature, filtered water to prevent shocking the fern's roots.

Humidity

- Ferns are native to humid environments. Maintain humidity levels between 40-60%.
- Use humidity trays, room humidifiers, or regular misting to provide adequate moisture.

Soil



Choose a well-draining potting mix with high organic matter content, such as peat moss or compost

Propagation

Ferns can be propagated via division (separation of the various offsets) during the growing season (April-July)
