CARING FOR

SANSEVIERIA

Sansevieria, commonly known as Snake Plant, is a hardy and low-maintenance plant that thrives in various conditions. Follow these care guidelines to ensure its health and vitality:

Sunlight



Best in indirect low light conditions

Watering

• Allow the soil to dry out completely between waterings.



- Water sparingly, approximately every 2-4 weeks, depending on humidity and light levels.
- Overwatering can lead to root rot, so err on the side of underwatering.

Soil



- Use well-draining succulent or cactus potting mix.
- Ensure the pot has drainage holes to prevent waterlogging.

Pruning



Trim dead or damaged leaves at the base using clean, sharp scissors or pruning shears.

Propagation

- Easily propagated through leaf cuttings or division of offsets.
- Allow cuttings to dry before planting in soil to prevent rot.
